Sub: Applications dated 01.04.2016 of the Professor-In-Charge, Institute of Post Graduate Ayurvedic Education and Research at Shyamadas Vaidya Shastra Pith, 294/3/1, A.P.C. Road, Kolkata-9, West Bengal to increase the admission capacity in existing 02 PG courses namely Dravyaguna- 2 to 6 seats and Kayachikitsa- 4 to 7 seats and to open a new PG course namely Panchakarma with 02 seats at Institute of Post Graduate Ayurvedic Education and Research at Shyamadas Vaidya Shastra Pith, SVSP, 294/3/1, A.P.C. Road, Kolkata-9, West Bengal, from the academic session 2017-18 under Section 13A of the IMCC ACT, 1970 – **Letter of Permission-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer your representation dated 03.11.2017 and to say that after careful consideration of the said representation and undertaking given by Joint Secretary (AYUSH), Department of Health & Family Welfare vide letter No.DAY/936/2017 dated 06.11.2017, in terms of criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and the approval towards conditional permission for UG/PG course(s) for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letters No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017; it has been decided –

- i) To convert the permission given for a period of not exceeding five years from the academic session 2016-17 to 2020-21 into conditional permission in 04 existing PG courses namely (i) **Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta – 02 seats**, (ii) **Kayachikitsa – 04 seats**, (iii) **Dravyaguna Vigyana – 02 seats** and (iv) **Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan – 02 seats** for the academic session 2017-18.
- ii) To grant the permission to increase the admission capacity in the 02 existing PG courses namely (i) **Dravyaguna – from 02 to 06 seats** and (ii) **Kayachikitsa – from 04 to 07 seats** and to open a new PG course namely **Panchkarma with 02 seats** for the academic session 2017-18.



2. Therefore, the college may take total 19 admissions in 04 existing as well as in 01 new PG course along with revised intake capacity in 02 existing PG courses.
3. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2017:
 - (i) All the Requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) All the Requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iii) All the requirement of "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016"; and
 - (iv) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
4. This permission to increase seats in 02 new PG courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan – from 02 to 06 seats and (ii) Kayachikitsa – from 04 to 07 seats and to open a new PG course namely Panchkarma – 02 seats, as mentioned above for the first admitted batch of 2017-18 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against this course appear for the final examination of the said course and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.
5. It is further to note that the permission granted for a period not exceeding 05 years (i.e. from the academic session 2016-17 to the academic session 2020-21) to the college for existing PG courses vide Ministry's letter No. R.17011/208/2016-EP(IM-1) dated 22.10.2016 is respectively withdrawn hereby and converted into conditional permission for the current academic year 2017-18 only. Therefore, to obtain the permission for academic session 2018-19 onwards and to take admissions in the above said permitted courses, college shall fulfil all the requirements of the IMCC Act, 1970 and the relevant Regulations made there under by 31.12.2017 and fulfilments of the conditions as mentioned above in para 03 respectively will be verified by the CCIM.
