Sub: Matter related to grant of conditional permission to the **Institute of Post-Graduate Ayurvedic Education & Research at Shyamdas Vaidya Shastra Pith, 294/3/1, A.P.C. Road , Kolkata, West Bengal with 19 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 06 seats,(ii) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-02 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-07 seats,(iv)Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-02 seats and (v) Panchakarma-02 seats under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19 –reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.13011/01/2016-EP(IM-1) dated 09.11.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 16-17.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations several deficiencies have been found. The CCIM has recommended for granting conditional permission for admission with 19 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 06 seats,(ii) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-02 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-07 seats,(iv) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-02 seats and (v) Panchakarma-02 seats subject to furnishing of undertaking from Secretary/Director/Commissioner of the Department of AYUSH/ISM of the State Government with an assurance that they will remove the shortcomings within three months.

3. After receiving of undertaking vide Letter No.DAY/746/2018 their letter dated 13.09.2018, submitted by the **Director of Ayurveda, Govt. of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Directorate of Ayurveda "Swasthya Bhawan", GN-29, Sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700091** to the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi. It has, therefore, been decided to **grant conditional permission to the Institute of Post-Graduate Ayurvedic Education & Research at Shyamdas**

Vaidya Shastra Pith, 294/3/1, A.P.C. Road , Kolkata, West Bengal for 19 seats in 05 PG Courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 06 seats,(ii) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-02 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-07 seats,(iv) Rog Nidan evum Vikriti Vigyan-02 seats and (v) Panchakarma-02 seats , for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to rectification of the following deficiencies within three months as undertaken by the State Government:-

- i. Web based computerised central registration system is not available.
- ii. There is no Clinical Registrar available against the requirement of 02 for 36 beds for 09 Clinical seats in existing 05 PG courses.
- iii. Availability of equipments and instruments in Dissection Hall, Rasa Shastra, Physiology, Prasuti Tantra, Bal Roga, Yoga Section, Casualty, OT, Shalakyia are 75% and in few departments is less than 75% against the requirement of 90% as per RMS.
- iv. Demonstration room is only 15 Sq.mt. available against the requirement of 25 Sq.mt. as per RMS.
- v. There are 08 RMOs, 03 Staff Nurses, 01 Pharmacist short against the requirement of 09, 14 and 04 as per RMS.
- vi. There are 01 DMO, 02 EMOs, 02 Registrars, 01 Matron, 02 Assistant Matron, 07 Ward Boys, 02 Dresser, 02 Office Staff, 01 Dark Room Attendant, 01 Pathologist, 01 X-Ray Technician, 01 Physiotherapist, 01 House Officer, 01 Panchkarma Nurse, 04 Panchkarma Assistant, 01 Yoga Teacher, 01 OT Attendant, 01 Nurse, 01 Midwife, 02 Lab. Technicians, 01 Peon, 01 Peon, 02 Workers, 01 Analytical Chemist not available in hospital as per RMS. Only 35.80% Staffs are available in hospital against the requirement of 80%.
- vii. There is 01 Lab. Technician is short in Rasa Shastra Dept. against the requirement of 02.
- viii. There are 01 Assistant Librarian, 01 Attendant, 01 Attendant in Samhita Dept., 01 Lab. Assistant & 01 Attendant in Rog Nidan Dept., 02 Attendant in Prasuti, Kaya., Kaumar., Shalakyia & Panchkarma dept. 02 Multipurpose worker are not available as per RMS. Only 52.38% Technical & other staffs are available against the requirement of 80%.
- ix. For PG course 01 Laboratory Technician, 01 Laboratory Assistant and 01 Attendant in Dravyaguna and Rog Nidann departments is not available as per PG Regulation. One Office Assistant or Data Entry Operator and One Attendant or Peon or Multipurpose Worker in each department is not also available in Ayurved Samhita, Swasthavritta, Agad Tantra, Prasuti, Kayachikitsa, Shalakyia Tantra, Kaumarbhritya and Panchkarma departments.
- x. Only 7675 books are available against the requirement of 10000 books as per MSR.
- xi. Central Registration Section is not available.
- xii. Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system is not available.

4. The College is also directed to fulfill the following requirements positively by the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018, which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2019-2020 onwards:

- (i) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and

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(iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled in toto.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2019-20.

6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
